This conference, jointly organized by the Association of Vietnamese Scientists and Experts in France (AVSE), the International School of Vietnam National University (Hanoi), and the International Society for the Advancement of Financial Economics (ISAFE), aims to bring together academics, practitioners and policymakers sharing their research findings and discussing current and challenging issues in banking and finance.
